To all athletes and enthusiasts of dog sledding sports from Mexico, we extend an invitation to take part in the event "The North Dryland Race," which is part of the series of races organized by the Mexican Federation of Canine Dryland (FEMEDCAN A.C.) to form the national selection that will attend the IFSS Latin American Championships 2024 and the IFSS World Championships 2025, under the following:

GUIDELINES

1. PARTICIPANTS

1.1 ATHLETES

Mexican nationals residing within the national territory or abroad, as well as foreign athletes eligible to represent Mexico in international events and who meet the requirements of this call.

1.2 TECHNICAL MANAGEMENT

Shall be responsible for organizing and conducting each of the sports disciplines, as well as for appointing and validating Judges, referees, and Technical Personnel. This body will be appointed by FEMEDCAN A.C."

3. SELECTION PROCESS

This event is eligible for ranking to participate in the IFSS Latin American Championships 2024 and the IFSS World Championships 2025, following the criteria established by FEMEDCAN A.C.

4. VENUE

4.1 ACCOMMODATION

6.2.1 PARTICIPATION KITS

Participant Kits will be provided to athletes and will include Race Chip, Sponsor Gifts, Surprise Gifts to be announced on the aforementioned social media platforms, and two camping nights area access, 1 dinner.

6.3 CHECK-IN

February 3, 2024, starting at 06:00 hrs.

6.4 ELIGIBILITY

The eligibility of each team is the responsibility of the participants themselves, as well as ensuring proper participation in each event, registration, entry, and accreditation in the respective categories.

6.4.1 THE ATHLETE

Valid ID Photo or Copy Scanned and signed Liability Waiver Letter.

6.4.2 THE DOG(S)

Up-to-date vaccination record photo or copy: complete and current within a year, including Rabies, Multiple (distemper, adenovirus, leptospirosis, influenza, coronavirus, and parvovirus) vaccines. Also, the bordetella vaccine (commonly known as kennel cough) Application deadline by January 13, 2024. Current deworming is recommended.





Dogs older than 18 months. A dog's age is calculated as of the first day of competition.

7. EQUIPMENT

The mandatory presentation of competition gear complies with the regulations.

7.1 CANICROSS

Harness
1.5 to 2.5 m extended tugline canicross belt

7.2 BIKEJORING/SCOOTER

Harness 2 to 3 m extended tugline Helmet

7.3 OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT

These items are not mandatory but can enhance safety during practice in any of the disciplines:

Gloves

Extra protections (elbow pads, knee pads, chest guard)

Boots for dogs

Goggles

Antenna

Appropriate terrain footwear

Quick-release carabiner (M.L.R)

Action camera.

8. RULES

8.1 RACE

The application of race rules will follow the guidelines set by the International Federation of Sleddog Sports (IFSS).

8.1.1 JUDGING AND RULE APPLICATION

As an official event of the Mexican Federation of Canine Dryland (FEMEDCAN A.C.), it will be responsible for enforcing these rules.

8.2 ADMINISTRATIVE

Matters arising from behavior outside the competition area that directly affect the conduct of this competition or cause damage to the event venue will be governed by the EVENT TECHNICAL COMMITTEE. Their decision will be final and binding.

9. MEDICAL SERVICES

An ambulance will be available during the event days during race hours. Veterinary medical services will also be available during the event days during race hours.

10. AWARDS

A minimum of 3 participants in each category is required for awards. If the minimum is not met, categories may be combined with earlier ones.

Participants will receive participation medals.

11. PRE-EVENT MEETING

Pre-event meetings will be held on the participants' welcome day, presided over by a representative of the Local Organizing Committee, a representative of FEMEDCAN A.C., and the Technical Director of the Competition.
